The biggest challenge is cleaning the bridges for the first time in twenty five years. The sidewalks on

the Ballard and University Bridges are protected from the street by high curbs. Those curbs trap grit and broken glass, and mechanical sweepers don't fit on the narrow sidewalks. So far, we have shoveled and swept over a ton of grit and grass from the Ballard Bridge. The sidewalk seems about a foot wider when it's cleaned up!

The four bridges are the Ballard, Fremont, University, and Montlake Bridges. Volunteers have been shoveling and sweeping the years-old accumulation of dirt from the sidewalks. The crew so far has consisted of

TRAVELING SOON? 6 READ THIS



If you travel on an airline and would like to take your bicycle, there are a few things that you may want to consider. Most airlines charge extra (up to \$45.00) to allow it on the plane. All airlines require that the bike is properly installed into a box. This procedure is not something that you will feel like doing in the middle of a busy airport, so it is best to have it done ahead of time.

At Seattle Bike Repair, we can save you the entire hassle! We can box your bicycle, and ship it UPS to a shop in the city that you are traveling to, where it will be properly assembled and waiting.

Or, if you prefer to box it yourself, here is the procedure. It requires a little time and energy, but it can be accomplished with the right tools and the right know how. Here it goes:

- *Remove the pedals
- *Put derailleurs into lowest gears
- *Remove the handle bars
- *Disconnect the brake cables if necessary
- *Remove the front wheel
- *Pad the bike well (blankets, towels etc...)
- *Turn the fork backwards
- *Tie handle bars to top tube
- *Tie the front wheel to the left side of bike
- *Slip the whole ensemble into the box
- *Wrap the pedals and put them in the box
- *Seal it up tight with packing tape
- *Shake well and bake at 350 degrees
- *Kick back and have a beer! Whew!
