GRAY'S ANATOMY OF THE WINTER CYCLIST

You might find this hard to believe but it is really quite fun to ride during the fall and less severe winter days. That is, if you have the right gear. If you can stay dry you'll find that the trick is not about keeping warm, it's about not overdressing. There are five essential items that will allow you to enjoy your bike these next few months.

Most important is a raincoat that breathes well. The Burley jacket has been our favorite for years. It is tried and true. In addition to its main feature, that it keeps you dry, this jacket has obviously been designed by someone who rides. You'll notice that the sleeve opening at the wrist is quite generous. This lets

you tuck your gloves under the cuff without fighting some tight elastic with the additional bulk of your gloves. I've never seen another cycling jacket that includes this. You'll also find oversize pit zips, pockets, lots of ventilation and an adjustable collar. In 15 years of trying other jackets we've never found another one that we like better!

Fenders are the next must. Many people just opt for a rear to keep the stripe away, but a front fender keeps all the crud from the wheel from flying up into your face. Not only will it keep you cleaner and drier, it will also make de-

scending safer.

You'll find that your fingers and toes really get cold. Cycling gloves are great because they are ergonomically designed to access your brake and shift levers more easily. Booties or waterproof socks are the ticket to keep you feet warm. Neoprene or waterproof booties are the most popular. With neoprene booties, your feet will still get wet but they tend

to stay warm(er). If you are riding an hour or less these usually do the trick. If you tend to have feet that are cold to begin with or are doing a longer ride you may wish to use other tactics as well. Burley also makes a waterproof bootie, however it is a little baggier than the traditional neoprene style.

Waterproof socks are another alternative. You need to have a little extra room in your shoes and you'll find that your shoes will get wet and dirty, but they sure do the trick. I often wear these if it's not raining when I leave but might rain later. They are small enough that you can carry them "just in case".

Whether you wear warm tights or rain pants depends on how hot you tend to get and how far you are riding. Many cyclists find that a warm pair of tights

is enough even when it is raining.
The tights that offer a rain panel in front (Pearl Izumi AmFib) are our favorites. Burley makes a pair of cycling rain pants that have a reflective cuff and large enough ankle opening so that you don't have to take your shoes off to get in or out of them.

Give it a try...you might find that you like it. And if all else fails, there's always the always the stationary trainer!



TIPS FOR RIDING INDOORS

Lots of people opt for indoor workouts this time of the year. It's a great way to stay in shape as well as ensure comfort on your bike this spring.

Putting your bike on a trainer instead of using an "exercise bike" has the advantage that it lets you use the same position, saddle and muscles, that you'll be using on the road. You can use it any hour you choose, in the comfort of your home. The only downside is that sometimes boredom sets in. But that is easy to conquer.

Have you ever tried pedaling with just one leg? Pull a chair up to a comfortable position alongside your bike and remove one of your feet from the pedal. Rest it on the chair and try pedaling for a minute or two with just one leg. Swap legs




and do it again. It's a fun exercise and it will help you improve your pedaling technique.

The best thing you can do with your trainer is to use a heart rate monitor with it. (see the coupon on below) You can do intervals, ladders, ride at a steady state, or any kind of workout you choose.

can use it to help pass the time. Try riding as hard as you can for .2 mile and then pedal really easy for 30 seconds. Then pedal hard for .4 with another 30 second rest. Increase by .2 until you hit a mile and then continue by decreasing the distance .2 each time until you have done 10 segments. You'll find you get a good workout in and hopefully the time will pass quickly. Ask us for other workouts and we'll be


