R&E invites you to experience this new level of service firsthand. Come on in and we'll talk bikes.



AVOID THE BREAK-A-WAY

Caution: Don't join this breakaway!

When participating in a club ride or in a race, many people enjoy the exhilaration of joining a breakaway. But, the breakaway that we recommend you don't pursue is "The Chain Breakaway." Anyone who has joined such a breakaway surely would attest to the fact that it was not very exhilarating. Chain breakage can not only be embarrassing, but it could also be dangerous. The good news is that it can be avoided with proper maintenance of the drivetrain.

Monitoring chain wear is essential to keeping everything running smoothly. This is done with the aid of a chain stretch indicator. This tool allows one to check how much the chain has stretched over time. If this is not done, an ignored chain can overstretch. When this occurs, not only does the danger of breakage increase, but excessive wear on the freewheel or cassette cogs and chainrings becomes evident (and expensive).

Don't mess with the chain stretch tool, come in to Seattle Bike Repair and let us measure it for you for free. We recommend replacing the chain every two thousand miles. Following this rule of thumb will assure you that you won't wear out other parts of the drive train prematurely. (A fifteen dollar chain every now and again is a better bargain than a seventy dollar cassette or one hundred dollars in chainrings, isn't it?)

Keeping track of chain wear will allow you to have the confidence in your parts when you join that breakaway or do anything else on your bike.



R&E's Helpful Hints for the participants of STP (And everyone else too.)

R&E offers congratulations to all of you who are taking on the challenge of participating in the famed Seattle to Portland ride. Along with this, we offer encouragement and a few helpful hints to make your STP experience more enjoyable. But even if you aren't riding in STP this year, you can still benefit from these practical tips. Here they are:

1. Proper bike fit- This is crucial for your happiness on the road to Portland. We at R&E feel very strongly about bike fit; for if it doesn't fit, you will not be comfortable and you will not be happy. We

don't want that. R&E uses numerous tools that can make your bike comfortable; these include a computer fitting system (Fit Kit) and a group of fitting experts that will carefully and professionally work with you to prevent and cure shoulder, knee, back, hand, butt (or worse) pain. Call today for your appointment!

2. Think about your equipment needs- Accessories play a major role in the comfort and enjoyment of any ride. Here are a few suggestions:

A comfortable saddle- Who hasn't experienced saddle soreness at some time in their cycling life? This could be the most important equipment purchase you ever make. Titanium rails not only save weight, but they also make the seat extremely comfortable. Many women have found relief from soreness in their 'girl parts' by purchasing a Terry saddle. Since saddles are such a "personal" decision, we at R&E offer a 30-day trial of any seat sold. If it is not comfy, trade it in for a different model.

Shorts- This could be the second most important equipment purchase you make. Shorts are like saddles; they are a very "personal" decision.. A good quality 6 or 8 panel short is only \$20 more than a "cheap" pair and well worth the ten cents a mile! Be sure you pack a second pair of shorts for day two. Salty, crusty shorts from yesterday are no fun for anyone.

Bar ends- This accessory is a must for those riders who will be piloting a mountain or cross bike. Bar ends offer multiple 📕 hand positions that will allow you to shift your weight in numerous ways (much like the drop-style handlebar on a touring or racing bike). Relegating yourself to a single hand position for two hundred miles will be torture. Take advantage of our front page coupon.

Slick tires- You'll be sorry if you try and ride 200 miles on big heavy mountain tires. A slick tire will make it easier and give you a smoother ride.

Eye wear- Of course we all know it is going to be beautifully sunny all the way to Portland, so having a good pair of sunglasses will keep you from squinting; or they will keep the rain out of your eyes, which brings us to the next item.

Rain wear- The best STP'er is ready for anything, even the rain. Believe us; you'll really appreciate it if you have it. Bring a plastic bag with arm holes if you must, but bring something. One thing to consider however is your metabolism. If you are a naturally warm rider, you'll bake in the plastic and create more of your own moisture than the sky ever would. A rain jacket with a lot of ventilation is best.

Gloves- A good pair of gloves will give more comfort to your hands and provide extra protection in the event of a crash.

3. Gearing- Having the proper gear ratios can make the ride more enjoyable. We can do just about anything to make your bike's gearing more efficient for your riding style and level of fitness. In fact, we've been known to convert a fourteen speed bike to a twenty-one speed bike on the road. Let us make the







To others, it's training for hours and hours, day after day, in order to be competitive on the NORBA racing circuit.


But to most of us, it's just heading out on a dirt road or a nice singletrack trailgetting some exercise, seeing some new places and enjoying the view.
