
R+E BIKE NEWS


At R+E we've been busy expanding our knowledge and skills this summer. Mark Wensman, ace mechanic, is now painting our frames. You all know Mark, he is the one with the zebra striped bike. John Watts has been picking up some lugless and tandem skills to add to his repertoire of fine hand-crafted frames. Estelle has done her first hand research into saddles this summer and has a wealth of suggestions for women riders searching for a good saddle. Maridee had taken over the mailorder load and is seen often on the counter when she's not hitting the books.

Angel's done it again! The inventor of Pocket Vise now is producing the Pocket Pro, a nifty touring T-tool. It has tips that fit the T-tool for regular and Phillips screws and 4, 5, and 6mm allens. Optional tips include 3mm allen, 1/8 allen for Blackburn, 1/4 allen for Phil hubs (Rodriguez tandem owners take note), and 8, 9 10mm sockets. It's USA produced entirely, guaranteed, and is the only way to tour. Look for the bright blue card POCKET PRO "T" and POCKET PRO POCKET VISE.

Those of you who have been in recently have been admiring the red ATB's that are gracing our ceiling. Lots of you have ben asking about them and we hope to clear up exactly what they are. These mountain bikes are Montanas. They were built to our specifications in Japan by a builder of big name brand mountain bikes. Well, the big name here is now Montana. We imported the frames bare so we could check and, if necessary, fix up each frame. We were impressed by the work and we had to do nothing but to decide what color they should all be. We chose a bright red super thick powdered epoxy paint. Then Grant Hildebrand designed us a decal and off we went. We have a lugged frame which costs \$283 and a lugless for \$491. Complete bikes start at \$549 for the lugged and \$749 for the lugless. As with all other Rodriguez and Erickson produced frames you have your choice of decal color. If we don't have a complete bike for you to test ride please forgive us; as soon as we assemble one and put in on the floor it seems to sell.


2B SRL Mount


2E Tandem Mount
