## OOL WEATHER RIDING

Dressing properly for cool weather riding is all about layering. It is also about having clothing that is easy to remove and carry with you if you no longer need to wear it. The most important layer is the one that is directly next to your skin. Wearing a high tec, wicking fabric will insulate you and keep you warm while wicking away perspiration so you are not chilled when you ride downhill. The outer layer needs to be windproof and preferably water resistant for Northwest weather. A vest made of a microfiber material and a pair of arm warmers make a great combination. If you have a vest or jersey with pockets it is easy to carry your arm warmers if you get to warm.

Your summer shorts coupled with leg warmers are perfect for cool days. You may start off with your legs covered in the morning and peel the armers off as the day warms up. Again they are easily stowed in a cycling pocket.

Mornings are often chilly and warm socks (coolmax, polypropylene, Phin-tech) are rider friendly. Come check out our selections and we'll explain your fabric choices and help you find a good fit.



## D WEATHER RIDING


Proper clothing for cold weather riding is a head to toe thing. You'll find that your torso, arms and legs will stay relatively warm by wearing fabrics that wick well. Finding proper items that will keep your ears, feet and hands warm is sometimes more difficult.

There are a number of ear bands that are designed to fit well under your helmet. You can also consider a helmet cover or a pair of ear covers that attach directly to your helmet straps.

When looking for gloves be sure you find a pair that allow you to pperate your brakes and shifters easily. Check out a pair of cycling specific gloves. They'll have some padding in the palm and some grippiness too.

Shoe covers come in many varieties. Most of them allow you to use a clipless pedal if you so desire. There are some on the market that easily work with sneakers.

There are lots of options for tights, jerseys and jackets as well. Come to our fashion show and you'll be able to see them all and get the most technical help possible.

It seems like everybody with a CNC machine is making bike parts these days. The problem is that most of what is being made is just lighter, stiffer, stronger, cooler versions of common parts like crank arms and brake levers. These CNC machined parts are beautiful and very, very expensive and only serve to make your bike a little lighter and a lot cooler. Cooler and lighter are good things, but how about some new stuff that makes your bike work better. Here are two of our new favorites ;-)

As you may already know, the excellent new Shimano V-brakes are very powerful but are very brake lever unfriendly. V-brakes


require extra brake lever cable pull to function. Most current levers do not have the required cable pull. Drop bar levers have very little cable pull, so up until now, using V-brakes on your touring bike or tandem was

not possible. Enter excellent widget #1: the Comtek C-TED (cable travel expanding device). C-TED is an in-line cable device that allows you to use any brake lever with V-brakes by multiplying the amount of cable being pulled. C-TED is an excellent solution to increase braking power, especially for tandems. C-TED's are also reasonably priced at \$35 per brake and work with all brake/brake lever combinations to increase braking power.

Excellent widget #2 is the Avid Roll-a-majig.

This lovely device replaces the tight turn in the cable housing at your rear derailleur. That tight cable turn causes cable friction and unwanted torque on the rear derailleur which reduces shifting efficiency and accuracy. If you have Grip-Shift shifters or a newer Shimano rear derailleur,

cable friction is an important issue. The Roll-a-majig replaces the curve in the derailleur housing with a smooth rolling pulley. The smoother cable run results in easier and more accurate shifting. This easy to install upgrade is a great bargain for \$25.

Everybody always notices that mechanics are greasy. It's not because they're slobs. It's not because grunge is a fashion statement. It's not because they like doing laundry. Mechanics are greasy because grease makes the world, and your bike, go round.

There are three very important applications for grease on your bike. All three uses are essential and the proper use of grease will make your bike safer, make it run better and make your components last longer.

The most obvious use of grease is for lubrication of the ball bearings in your headset, bottom bracket and hubs. The grease in these areas reduces friction and provides protection to the bearing surfaces. Lower friction in your hubs decreases rolling resistance and increases efficiency. Grease in the bottom bracket decreases pedaling resistance and also increases efficiency. In all cases, grease protects the bearing surfaces from the degrading effects of moisture and protects the components from wear and tear. The grease and bearings in all these bearing surfaces should be replaced every 2,000 to 3,000 miles, depending on the riding conditions. This maintenance will ensure smooth operation and will prevent premature wear on the bearing surfaces. Failure to replace the grease when it is gritty and broken down can result in irrepairable damage to the bearing surfaces. This maintenance procedure can be avoided by replacing your components with cartridge sealed style components. These cartridge bearings do contain ball bearings and grease, but they are sealed against the elements and do break down as quickly. When the cartridge eventually wear out (in 10,000 miles or more) they can be replaced and there is never any danger of damage to the component itself. Mileage and grit are not the only enemies of the grease in your bearings. Grease will degrade with time and an old bike with few miles may need the bearing repacked. Consult your friendly SBR mechanic or sign up for the SBR overhaul course.

A second important use of grease on your bike is on the cables control-

ling the brakes and derailleurs. Application of a small amount of grease to the cables before they are threaded through the housing will help the cable run more smoothly and will help prevent the cables from corroding. Cable friction from corrosion is a major cause of shifting problems. Simply pulling and greasing the derailleur cables will solve many shifting problems. If the cables are very corroded, replace them. Cable are inexpensive. Make sure to grease the new cables when they are installed. Contrary to popular belief, cables threaded into lined housing should definitely be greased. The only exception to this rule is the new Gore-tex sealed cable system that uses a Gore-tex coating in place of lubricant.

The third and not so obvious use of grease is its application on all threaded fasteners and on the seat post and stem. This may be the most important use of grease. Greasing threads ensures that the fastener being tightened is properly torqued without applying excessive force to the fastener. Most importantly, your components will be tightly mounted to the frame i.e. your pedals won't fall off or your bars or stem won't slip. Further, when it comes time to remove components for servicing, they will come off cleanly and no bolts will shear. Grease on the seat post and stem prevents these components from becoming seized in the frame from corrosion. It is possible for a seat post or stem to become permanently stuck, ruining the frame or fork. Make sure your seat post and stem are thoroughly greased and are moving freely in the frame set.

Many types of grease are appropriate for bike use. The grease that you choose for your bearings is definitely usable for your cables and threads. SBR uses Pennzoil 705 Multipurpose white grease for all applications. Bicycle specific grease from Finish Line and Phil Wood are also excellent.

Be greasy like SBR mechanics, your bike will love you for it.






